



SALK seeks dedicated Head coach

SALK is expanding its operations, and is therefore seeking Sweden's best Head coach. This new position includes leading the athletic operations for the club's competing juniors and professional players, as well as having an overall responsibility for the education of SALK's approximately 30 coaches. As responsible for education, your aim is to create a common thread for SALK's coach managed activities. Further, being a coach on the court will be a significant part of your work, with an estimated scope of approximately 20 hours per week. On the court the focus will primarily be on SALK's competing junior players. The responsibility also includes, among other things, timetabling and to plan and monitor the players' participation in tournaments.

As Head coach for SALK you will have a key role in the club. You will share the ambition to develop players on a very high international level. It is a full time position with varying working hours from week to week. Traveling to tournaments will occur.

You should possess a deep knowledge of tennis, and have a strong desire to develop Swedish tennis. Experience as a tennis coach on a high level is required. Completed tennis education, in particular coaching education, would be an asset. You should be ambitious, service minded and passionate about developing up-and-coming tennis players. Administrative skills are an advantage, as well as computer literacy and basic knowledge of economy.
